BECOME TIVO CLUB MEMBER AND PUBLISH ON TIVO POSTER

TIVO Poster is both print (noticeboard) and online publication dedicated to promote collaboration, enquiring, creativity and critical thinking skills to learners through collaborative writing and publication. TIVO Poster allows students of different levels (Primary, Secondary and college students) to research and write on topical issues for publication consideration. Follow the following procedures to have your work published on TIVO POSTER

- 1. Visit <u>www.tivo.or.tz</u>
- 2. Register yourself by filling the required fields and receive a confirmation email,
- 3. Click on **TIVO Club link** to access **TIVO Poster Templates**,
- 4. Download TIVO POSTER Template of your interest but consider a monthly theme you wish it published,
- 5. Organise yourselves into a team of three students and start writing basing on the guidelines on the poster template,
- 6. Get a teacher mentor/supervisor/expert basing on a subject/field you are writing about,
- 7. Give your work to another student for review (review comment to be written on a review column (the right top column of TIVO poster template),
- 8. Give your work to language or literature teacher to edit the language used in your article,
- 9. Write at least three references used in writing your article (on the right bottom column-bibliography, use MLA style),
- 10. Send your article to info@tivo.or.tz and CC to inclusivetanzania@gmail.com .
